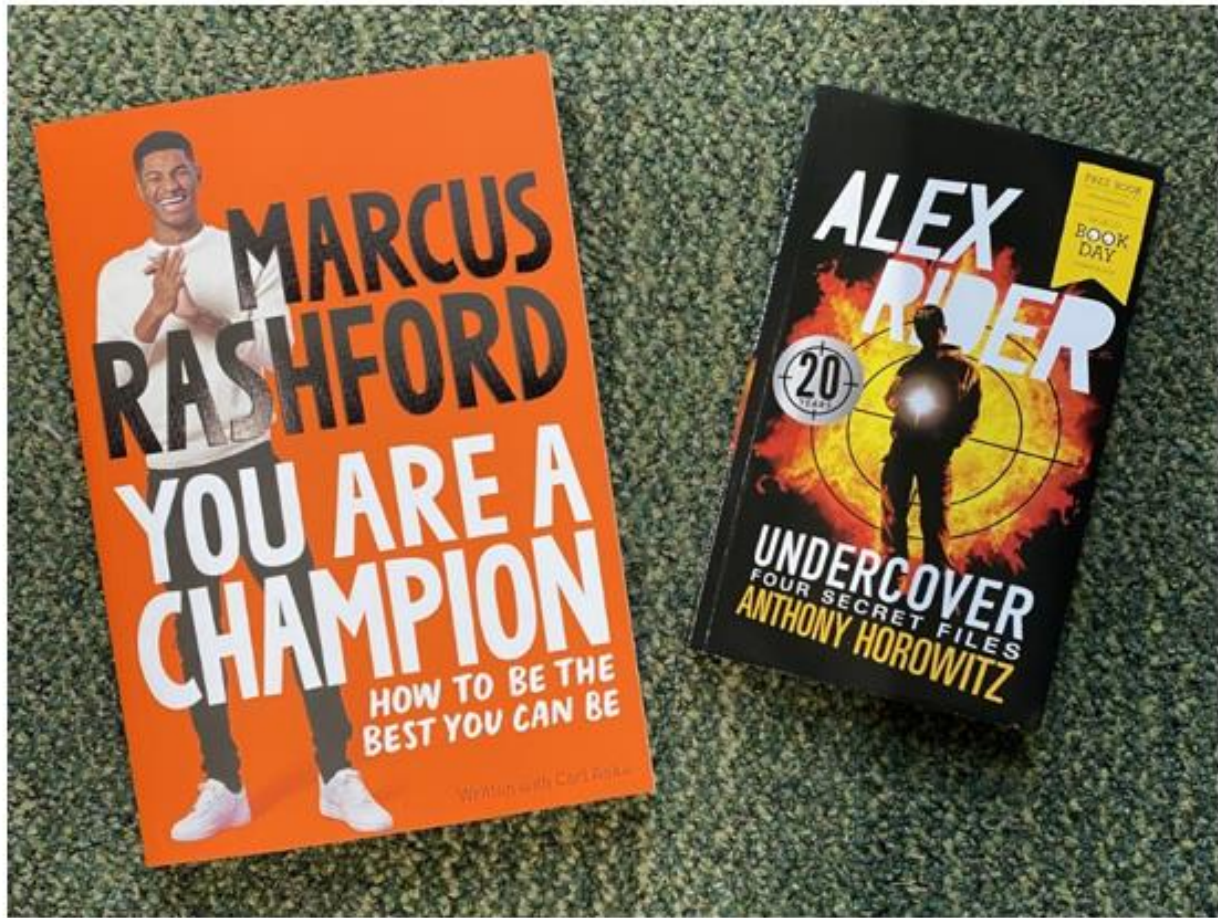

and he hobbled off home. He'd had enough.

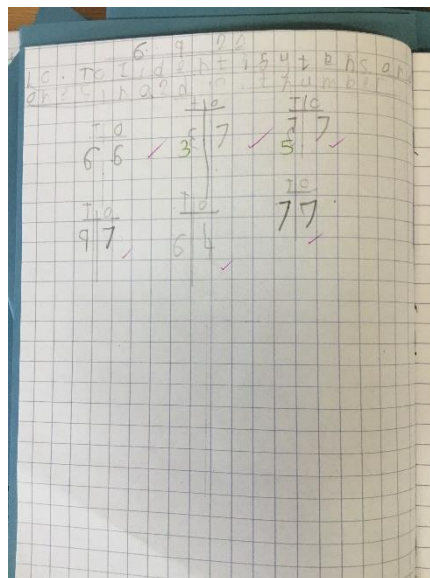
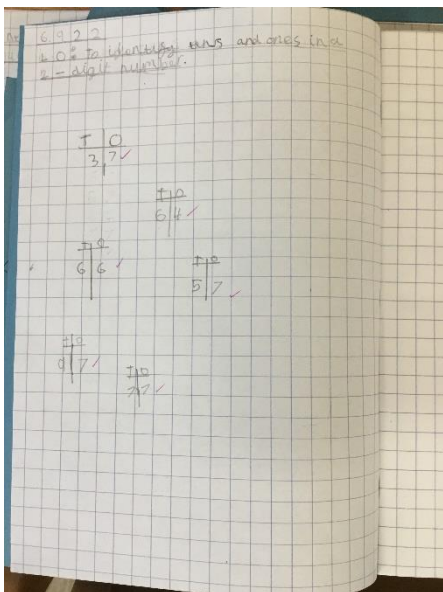
