Dear Parent/Carer,

It has been lovely to see so many more children in school this week having the opportunity to be with their new teachers. Yesterday, we had 147 children in school, including some of the new pupils who are joining the Place Farm family in September, which is absolutely lovely. White polo shirt with logo
Grey trousers/shorts/skirt/pinafore

A tie is not compulsory in EYFS

Black school shoes (or black trainers) with white or grey socks

Year One to Six

Blue sweatshirt/cardigan with logo
White collared shirt and tie
Grey trousers/shorts/skirt/pinafore or summer dress (blue gingham)

Black school shoes (or black trainers) with white or grey socks
