

Home Learning in Year One

Each day pupils are set 5 tasks to complete: Maths, English, Phonics, Handwriting and Creative or Physical. In addition to these, pupils are given optional learning tasks that they might like to complete, for example, listening to a story read by Miss Bailey or Mrs Pullen, taking part in some guided relaxation or going bird watching. Every week pupils also choose one set of Spellings which they would like to practise daily across the week. Parents and/or carers upload photographs and videos to Class Dojo and pupils enjoy being given points for their hard work. Miss Bailey and Mrs Pullen select one piece of work to give pupils feedback on each day. Pupils love listening to this feedback and their next steps!

Pupils have already completed lots of amazing learning which Miss Bailey and Mrs Pullen have been really impressed with. They have especially enjoyed: making nature photo frames, bug boxes, drawing daffodils and dinosaurs, making lava lamps, going bird watching, doing yoga, learning new dance routines, measuring different objects using their hands, finding objects that are taller or shorter than one metre, writing about their 'Happy News', favourite stories and questions that they would like to ask other people.
