


Year Two – Home Learning


During our time at home, Year Two have been going above and beyond with their home learning. They have been taking part in a wide range of subjects including Maths, English, Science, Geography, History, Music and more. We would like to share just some of the work that has been going on at home during this time.



During, maths at home the children have been challenging themselves and getting creative. This photo shows one of our children getting creative when practising measuring and capacity during one of our maths warm ups. As well as this, we have been looking at addition, subtraction, multiplication, division, fractions and telling the time.



In English, the children have been working really hard on their handwriting, spelling, letter formation and use of punctuation. The children have been engaging in different activities including Rainbow spellings and cursive handwriting tasks.



In geography, we have been reconsolidating their knowledge of the world.

So far this year we have been focussing on the world's rainforests. As part of the home learning, the children have been working on recalling their knowledge of the world's continents, and the oceans of the world. As part of this, we have been using songs to help us, which the children have carried on learning at home. Continuing in geography, but a little bit closer to home, we have been learning about the countries of the UK and the capital cities of each country.
